Announcement / Invitation

1. General

The **Bavarian Open Competition** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2012, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2012, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Bavarian Open Competition** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2 b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 1420 or any update of this Communication, as well as this announcement.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 1420 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must to be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

Entries: All Members of the International Skating Union and their respective Member Clubs are invited to take part in the competition.

Competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation. The OC will only accept entries from Clubs, when they are stamped by the respective Member Federation.

Entries into Pair Categories are not limited.

Single and Ice Dance Categories:

Members may enter into each category with up to 3 Skaters/Couples. Substitute Entries may be nominated. Due to the total number of entries in each category the OC will decide, how many Substitute Skaters/ Couples can be entered. Please note that the organizer may divide categories with too many entries into subgroups. Attached entry forms have to be filled in precisely and sent to the Organizer:

Please Note: **Entries will not be accepted, if the Entry Fee had not arrived at the Organizers account in time. Entries will be confirmed to the Members/Clubs concerned.**

Expenses:
Competitors: The organizer will not cover any expenses of competitors.

Officials: Members are kindly requested to nominate one International/ISU TS, TC or Judge. Double duty (Singles & Pairs and Dance) are very welcome. The nomination of one substitute is appreciated. The final composition of the panels will be done after the Entry deadline and will be published to the participating Member in time. The organizer will cover accommodation for **invited** officials (Judges, Referees, Technical Panel) only. Meals for all invited Officials will be provided at the ice-rink during the days of competition.

Time-Schedule: The competition will start on Wednesday, February 6, 2013 and will be finished on Sunday, February 10, 2013. A detailed Time-Schedule will be sent to all participating Members soon after the Entry deadline.

Accreditation: The official accreditation is at the main entrance of the Ice Rink. Accreditation will be given to Competitors, Judges and Coaches, as well as Team Officials, as long as they are officially entered with the respective entry form.

Draws: The first Draw will be held on the day prior to the respective competition. A special Draw Schedule will be published with the Official Time Schedule.

Results: The determination and publication of the results will be done according to ISU Technical Rules for Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2012, Rule 352 and 353.

Awards: The first three best placed competitors and couples in each discipline will be awarded with Medals or Trophies. Diplomas will be provided for all participants. The Award Ceremonies will be published with the official Time-Schedule.

Liability: In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Bavarian Open Figure Skating and Ice Dance 2012, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

Duration: 2 min., 50 sec., +/- 10 sec

Free Dance In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2012, Rule 610. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 1721 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 4 min. +/- 10 sec.

ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2012, Rule 610 paragraph 2 (required elements) and the respective ISU Communication must be observed.

Juniors

Age Requirements: In accordance to ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2010, Rule 108.2.b

Short Dance In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2012, Rule 609 and all pertinent ISU Communications.

Rhythms, required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communications 1721, 1738 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 50 sec., +/- 10 sec

Free Dance In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2012, Rule 610. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communications 1721, 1738 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 4 min. +/- 10 sec.

ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2012, Rule 610 paragraph 2 (required elements) and the respective ISU Communication must be observed.

Advanced Novices

Age Requirements: In accordance with ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2010, Rule 108.2.d

Pattern Dance: In accordance with ISU Communication No. 1721 and 1760 **Guidelines for International Novice Competitions** Ice Dance Advanced Novice

The following **2 Pattern Dances** are to be skated.

Rocker Foxtrott and Kilian

The key points are listed in the respective ISU Communication.

The **music** must be chosen in accordance with the Rhythm of the Pattern Dance. The **tempo** throughout the required Sequences must be constant and in accordance with the required tempo of the Pattern Dance (see ISU Handbook Ice Dance 2003) plus or minus 2 beats per minute.

Notes: The chosen music may be a tune from ISU Ice Dance music. For the application of Rule 608 paragraph 1.d) with music provided by the Couple, it is specified that the start of the first Step of the dance must be on beat 1 of a measure (unless otherwise specified in the description of the dance).

Free Dance: Duration: 3 min +/- 10 sec
In accordance to ISU Communication No. 1721 and 1760 **Guidelines for International Novice Competitions** Ice Dance Advanced Novice

Music

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD or MP3 format. In accordance with Rule 343 all units must show the Competition event, the Competitors name, the Members name and the exact running time of the Music (not skating time) including any starting signal, and must be submitted at the time of registration.
